The role: The Production Manager will bring excellence to the worship / creative team through high quality audio engineering, videography and editing, lighting, and creative innovation.

Meet Northway: Northway Church began in 1998 as a church plant of Vineville Baptist Church in Macon, Georgia to reach a community of largely unchurched neighborhoods located on the north side of the city. Since 1998, the church has grown from 2-300 individuals attending on Sunday to approximately 1100-1200 attending worship each week. The church sits on 28 acres of property strategically located between growing commercial and residential areas.

We believe God has placed us in Middle Georgia to be a catalyst for spiritual change in our community. As our vision statement reads: "When the Gospel transforms a life, it also transforms a home, a workplace, and a city. Northway Church is committed to developing leaders who will take the Gospel to our city by serving, loving, and sacrificing with no limits. We are for the Gospel and we are for the City. Let's go!"



Northway recently completed a \$7 million expansion which includes a new student center, an expanded foyer, and a retail coffee shop (cathedralcoffee.org) open to the public Monday- Saturday. We've also recently expanded our Weekday Preschool to include an extended day option for families. In the past year, Northway has truly become a church whose ministry is operating seven days a week.



About the Ministry: Northway Worship is made up of a team of about 40 different vocalists/musicians and about 15 tech volunteers. Our team is extremely talented and passionate about seeing worship ministry at Northway accomplish its vision of responding and leading people to respond to the glory of God. Our team leads Sunday Morning, Middle School, High School, College, and Celebrate Recovery services. Each service typically has a full band with full sound, lighting, and visual needs. Our staff is currently comprised of a Worship Director, Music Coordinator, Videography / Media Director, and a Worship Intern. We have great staff culture and talent within our staff team but as our technology needs continue to grow we need even more help to handle all the different services happening.



About Macon: Macon is a family-oriented, medium-sized city in middle Georgia. Macon and its surrounding communities have a population of about 150,000. Macon is home to Mercer University, Wesleyan College, and Middle Georgia State University. There are a number of educational choices for families with children: Bibb County schools, two new charter schools, several private schools, Monroe County schools, as well as Houston County schools. Macon also has a low cost of living, but with quick access to cultural and sporting events in Atlanta.

What you Bring:

The following describes many of the characteristics of the ideal candidate for this position:

Education:

An undergraduate degree is preferred. Any degree or certified training in AVL is a bonus but not required.

Experience:

Ideally the Production Manager has a minimum of 3-5 years experience in high level audio engineering as well as knowledge and hands on experience in lighting and videography. The Production Manager has experience having led volunteer teams in the past and has experience developing volunteers.

Personal Qualifications:

- Must be a born again believer with maturing relationship with Christ
- Must show an active desire to spend daily time in God's word for the purposes of growing your relationship with the Lord and applying The Word to your life.
- Must be willing to participate in our team vision of being disciples who make disciples.
- Help produce and oversee Sunday Morning worship with an emphasis on audio engineering.
- Ability to oversee Sunday morning camera, lighting, and audio volunteers when needed.
- Oversee student service audio engineering and lighting/video volunteers.
- Extensive knowledge of one of the following: Pro Tools, Logic Pro, Reason, Ableton, Studio One.
- Basic knowledge of video editing software such as: Final Cut Pro, Adobe Premiere Pro, Etc.
- Experience operating digital sound consoles in a live setting.
- Basic knowledge of lighting design and videography / editing
- Ability to pre-produce / post-produce Sunday audio / video content.
- Ability to inventory and maintain production equipment.
- Willing to assist in video shoots and video editing throughout the week if necessary.
- Skill to prepare pre-packaged livestream content.
- Ability to prepare production for retreats / events.
- Knowledge to record studio content for audio.
